## INTRODUCTION

INDIGO, a simplified joint stock company, registered with the Nanterre Trade and Companies Register under number 843 148 800 and whose registered office is located at 18, rue de l’Ancienne Mairie – 92100 Boulogne-Billancourt, France, strongly encourages you to read this privacy policy carefully.

This Privacy Policy describes how INDIGO, in its capacity as data controller, manages the processing of your Personal Data collected in connection with your use of the Indigo Application accessible at [the following address](#) (the “**Application**”).

<b>User</b>	Refers to any person who downloads the Application and/or register and/or sign in.

## 1. WHY DO WE COLLECT YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

INDIGO collects your personal data when you register, log in and use the Application in order to carry out all of the goals/purposes detailed in the table below.

Your personal data:

- Are obtained and processed fairly and lawfully;
- Are stored for specific and legitimate purposes;
  - Are used in accordance with those purposes;
  - Are adequate, relevant, and not excessive in relation to those purposes;
- Is subject to precautions to ensure the security and confidentiality of the data in order to prevent it from being damaged, altered, destroyed, or communicated to unauthorised third parties.

### **3. WHAT PERSONAL DATA ARE COLLECTED BY INDIGO?**

You provide information to Indigo when creating your user account or Page, posting an advert, writing comments, subscribing to newsletter, or contacting Indigo through the Application (via email, phone, social networks, etc.).

Technical information (e.g., IP address, browser information, etc.) are also transmitted to Indigo by your device when you use the Application.

The information collected by Indigo is shown in the summary table above.

### **4. ON WHAT BASIS DOES INDIGO PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA?**

As described in the summary table above, the Treatments implemented by Indigo are based on (i) the performance of the contract for use of the Application between you and Indigo, (ii) Indigo's legitimate interests, or (iii) your consent.

You may not object to such Processing when it is necessary for the performance of the exchange contract or the contract for use of the Application between you and Indigo.

Where the Processing is based on Indigo's legitimate interest, you may object to it. To do so, please refer to Section 9 regarding your rights.

When the Treatment is based on your consent, you can withdraw it at any time by sending an email to the following address: [data@indigo.world](mailto:data@indigo.world), or in the privacy settings in the application.

## **5. COOKIES**

### **5.1. What are Cookies used for and why are they collected**

Cookies are text files that contain small amounts of information that are downloaded to your device when you visit a web page or use an application. Cookies are then sent back to the original web page or application on each subsequent visit, or to another web page or application that recognizes that cookie.

### **5.2. IMPORTANT CONSENT INFORMATION**

The deposit or reading of certain cookies does not require the prior collection of your consent, either because they do not process any Personal Data concerning you, or because they are strictly necessary for the provision of the service you request.

This consent shall be valid for a maximum of 13 months.

The deposit or reading of cookies other than those mentioned in the previous paragraph requires your prior consent and is detailed in the table above (Article 2).

You can, at any time, oppose the deposit or reading of the cookies we use, either by deleting them from your device or by modifying your browser settings.

### 5.3. WHAT COOKIES WE USE

We use different types of cookies, the purposes of which are described below.

- **Technical Cookies**

These cookies are necessary for the operation of the Application. They allow you to use the main features of the Application (e.g. access to your account). Without these cookies, you will not be able to use our Application correctly. These are cookies deposited by INDIGO or by third parties that relate to the operation or security of our Application.

Indigo uses cookies for its legitimate interest in :

- improve the operation of the Application;
- detect, prevent and resolve fraud, spam, abuse, security incidents and other harmful activities;
- identify the user (in case of user reporting and for moderation of reported comments);
- improve the user experience;
- enable and facilitate communication by electronic means about the Application.

You may object to it and delete them using your browser settings; however your user experience may be degraded or impossible for security reasons. These cookies are detailed in the table above (article 2).

- **Analytical Cookies**

These are third party cookies that enable us to know the use and performance of our site, to establish statistics, volumes of frequentation and use of the various elements of our site/application (content visited, paths) enabling us to improve the interest and ergonomics of our services (the most frequently consulted pages or sections, the most read articles, etc.).

If you give your agreement (consent), cookies will be deposited allowing us to collect the information strictly necessary for the purposes described in the table below. Indigo uses Google Analytics, a web analytics tool that helps Indigo understand how users interact with the Application. Google Analytics uses persistent cookies to track user interactions. This information is used to generate reports and to help Indigo improve the Application. These reports reveal trends in the Application without identifying individual visitors. You can disable Google Analytics without affecting the way you visit the App - for more information on how to disable Google Analytics on all the websites you use, visit this [page Google](#).

Any settings that you may make will be likely to modify your use of the Application as well as your conditions of access to certain services/functions requiring the use of cookies. You can authorise or refuse the storage of cookies in your terminal and change the latter's settings at any time.

If you have enabled cookies in your browser software, they are stored in a dedicated area on your device.

If you refuse to accept Cookies on your device or if you delete the Cookies stored on your device, you will no longer be able to benefit from a certain number of functionalities that are necessary for browsing certain areas of the website. Where applicable, we decline all responsibility for the consequences linked to the impaired functioning of our website

resulting from the impossibility for us to record or consult the Cookies necessary for their functioning and which you have deleted or refused.

#### **6. TO WHOM IS YOUR PERSONAL DATA DISCLOSED?**

As detailed in the summary table above, access to your personal data is limited to :

- Employees and agents of Indigo, empowered by virtue of their position and bound by an obligation of confidentiality;
- Subcontractors of Indigo under contract to perform the tasks necessary for the proper operation of the application and its services, namely cloud storage of your Personal Data (Amazon Web Services which stores your Personal Data in Ireland).

In the performance of their services, Indigo’s subcontractors comply with the provisions of the GDR.

Indigo will also disclose your Personal Data to third parties if Indigo disposes of any of its entities and/or assets and your Personal is affected by such disposal.

Indigo will share your Personal Data with judicial authorities, independent administrative authorities or any other organisation if required by law.

In addition, Indigo informs you that some of your personal data may be passed on to partners; details of the personal data and partners involved are set out in the summary table above.

## 7. IS YOUR PERSONAL DATA TRANSMITTED OUTSIDE THE EEA?

Most of the Recipients of Personal Data are located in France or in a Member State of the EEA.

For the purposes of the Indigo newsletter, your email address is transferred to the United States where the data of Indigo's service provider, Mail Chimp, is hosted. Mail Chimp has certified its compliance with the approved Privacy Shield certification scheme.

## 8. HOW LONG IS YOUR PERSONAL DATA KEPT?

Indigo retains your Personal Data for the periods of time described in the summary table above.

After you have terminated use of the Application, Indigo will retain your account data for a period of 5 years and then store your Personal Data in an aggregated and anonymous format.

## 9. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS?

In accordance with the Data Protection Regulations, you have rights in relation to the Personal Data that Indigo holds about you.

The table below provides an overview of these rights and how you can exercise them. These rights can be exercised by written request, which must be accompanied by valid proof of identity with the signature of the holder. To exercise one of your rights, you can:

Please note that for each of these rights Indigo may have valid legal grounds to deny your request, in which case Indigo will inform you.

All requests must be clear, precise and justified.

You will receive a response within one month of receipt of your request; however, this period may be extended up to two months if the request is complex and/or too numerous.

INDIGO does not charge fees for the processing of requests for access rights, but reserves the right to charge fees when this concerns requests for additional copies of information that has already been provided to you, and for manifestly unfounded or excessive requests, in particular when such requests are repetitive.

The user is informed that in case of opposition to the processing or if he or she provides false or fictitious data, the services related to the collection of the data will not be rendered, INDIGO cannot be held liable in any way in this respect.

<b>Right of access</b>	You have the right to know whether Indigo processes Personal Data about you and, if so, to access such Data and certain information about how Indigo uses it and with whom Indigo shares it. You may request a copy of such Data
<b>Right to portability</b>	You may request to receive the Personal Data that Indigo holds about you, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and the right to request that Indigo transfer such Personal Data to another party (i) if the Processing is necessary for the performance of the contract or (ii) if the Processing is based on your consent and where the Processing is carried out using automated processes.
<b>Right of correction</b>	If you believe that the Personal Information Indigo holds about you is inaccurate or incomplete, you have the right to request that it be corrected or amended.
<b>Right of deletion</b>	You may request that Indigo delete your Personal Data in the following circumstances: (i) when you believe that it is no longer necessary for Indigo to hold such Personal Data, (ii) when Indigo is processing it on the basis of your consent and you wish to withdraw your consent, (iii) when Indigo is processing your data on the basis of its legitimate interest and you object to such processing, (iv) when you no longer wish Indigo to use your data to solicit you commercially or (v) when you believe that Indigo is unlawfully processing your Personal Data.
<b>Right to Limitation of Treatment</b>	You may ask Indigo to limit the Processing of your Personal Data (i) if you dispute the accuracy of your Personal Data, (ii) if the Processing is unlawful and you object to its deletion, (iii) if you believe that Indigo no longer needs your Personal Data but that it is still necessary for you to establish, exercise or defend legal claims, or (iv) if you have objected to the Processing of the Personal Data that Indigo holds about you.
<b>Right of opposition</b>	You have the right to object to the Processing of your Personal Data by Indigo and Indigo will consider your request. To this end, please provide Indigo with details of your reasoning so that Indigo can assess whether there is a legitimate and compelling reason for Indigo to continue to process such data or whether Indigo needs to process it in order to exercise or defend its rights in court.
<b>Right to give post-mortem instructions</b>	You have the right to set guidelines for the storage, deletion and disclosure of your Personal Data after your death.



## **10. SECURITY**

Personal data shall be processed in such a way as to ensure appropriate security by means of physical, technical or organisational measures appropriate to the state of the art in this field, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction or damage.

Depending on the needs, risks, costs and purpose of processing, these measures may include pseudonymisation and encryption of data.

INDIGO sets up a procedure to regularly test, analyse and evaluate the effectiveness of the technical and organisational measures to ensure the security of the treatment.

However, it should be pointed out that the Internet is not a completely secure environment and INDIGO cannot guarantee the security of the transmission or storage of information on the Internet.
